GOLF ETIQUETTE

Etiquette and integrity are the very heart of golf. If every golfer practices proper etiquette on the course, slow play would be, virtually eliminated.

Abide by the Dress Code while playing golf on course/driving range.

GENTLEMEN

LADIES

- Denim Jeans are prohibited.
- T-shirts with collar/polo neck may only be worn.
- Golfers should wear appropriate golf shoes/flat sports shoes.
- Jogging Suit and T-shirt without collar are strictly prohibited.
- Tailored shorts of appropriate length only be worn. (4' above the knee roll)
- Caps if worn must be with the peak in front.

- May wear T-shirts/Blouses.
- Trousers normal length shorts/skirts/capris.
- Denim Jeans or miniskirts, including cut offs.
- Jogging shorts, tights, track suits etc, are not permitted.

* Starter can prevent a player from playing if dress code is violated.

The Do's & Don'ts on the Golf Courses

- Arrive at the course on time, tee times are tight. Don't hold up the rest of your two, three or foursome, if for some reason a partner is late, notify the starter, so he can readjust the tee-off times.
- Replacing the divots is one of the cornerstones of proper golf etiquette. Replacing the divots is also essential to maintain the course.
- Before stepping on the green, leave your bags away from the skirts (fringe) of the green.
- The green is more fragile than the rest of the course. Please treat it so, walk softly, never run on the green, remember to pick up your feet so as not to leave a long, dragging clean marks on the carpet.
- Safety on the course is of utmost importance. Be concerned about your safety and safety of all other including ground staff. Course management is not responsible under any circumstances in case of injury to others. Golfer whose ball causes injury of any incident will be responsible with consequences.
- If the staff on duty observes, that a player is either a beginner or a dangerous player, he has the right to request such player to stop play.

THE 20 MOST IMPORTANT CHANGES TO THE RULES OF GOLF 2020



1. Search time reduced from 5 minutes to 3 minutes.
2. Ball moved during search- Replace no penalty.
3. Embedded ball free relief anywhere through the course.
4. Measuring a drop-Use Longest Club (Except Putter).
5. Dropping Drop from knee height rather than shoulder.
6. Taking stance on wrong green is not permitted.
7. Ball unintentionally hits player or equipment - No penalty.
8. Double Hit- No penalty. Now only counts as the 1 stroke.
9. Touching sand in bunker incidentally is permitted.
10. Loose impediments can be removed anywhere including hazards.
11. Dropping a ball out of bunker - 2 penalty strokes.
12. Water Hazards - Now called "Penalty Areas".
13. Touching Ground in penalty Area - No Penalty.
14. Ball moves on green after being marked replace without penalty.
15. Ball accidentally moved on putting green replace no penalty.
16. All damages to green can now be repaired.
17. Positioning a club for alignment is now not permitted.
18. Caddie assisting with alignment is now not permitted.
19. Putting with flag stick in hole is now permitted.
20. Ball wedged against flag stick and side of hole is deemed as holed.
