# SAFETY OF SENIOR CITIZENS

Make safety a habit

Follow these simple safety tips:

## Dos

- *Install doors with magic eye, door chain & auto-lock on the door. If possible, keep a pet dog.*
- *Look through the magic eye before opening the door.*
- *Always go out in a group for morning and evening walks.*
- *Install a CLI facility in your telephone.*
- *Connect your house to the neighbour's with an alarm bell.*
- *Keep important telephone numbers handy. Inform your nearest police station and neighbours if you spot a suspicious person around your residence.*
- *Keep your door locked from inside while sleeping.*
- *Ensure police verification of your domestic help/driver/watchman/tenant.*
- *Take the services of only those plumbers/electricians/carpenteres/labourers who are known or recommended by the building association.*
- *Keep in touch with the Police Station.*

## Don'ts

- *Don't leave valuables at home.*
- *Don't make any ostentatious display of cash and jewellery.*
- *Don't open the door to strangers/unidentified persons. Do not allow courier service employees, hawkers etc. inside the house.*
- *Don't ignore suspicious incidents/persons; inform the police.*
- *Don't take walks in dark/lonely alleys.*
- *Don't allow domestic helps to have access to your cupboards, safes etc.*
- *Don't keep large amounts of cash/jewellery at house.*
- *Don't discuss important family/property issues in front of strangers/domestic help.*
- *Don't discuss your programme in front of your domestic help.*
- *Don't keep a domestic help who is unverified or unverifiable.*
- *Don't start a conversation with or accept eatables from a stranger.*
